



## HOW WE WORK

### Partnerships

KVINFO joins Danish and local organisations and institutions in mutually beneficial partnerships. These partnerships form the core of all our projects.

In 2015 close to 8,000 persons were directly involved in KVINFO's projects and in total nearly 120,000 people were influenced by programme interventions.

### Dialogue

In KVINFO, we believe in dialogue. KVINFO values the ability to tolerate, listen to, respect, and learn from diverging views and dialogue is a cross-cutting element of our projects.

Since 2006 KVINFO has had more than 100 partnership projects, working with civil society as well as the public and private sectors. 35 projects are currently active.

### Human Rights

KVINFO is determined to apply a human rights-based approach in all projects, while acknowledging that different contexts and sectors require different strategies.

Over 10 years KVINFO's international projects has had a total budget of approximately 190 million Danish Kroner (25.5 million €).

## INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS FOR 10 YEARS

KVINFO's international work is currently concentrated in the Middle East and North Africa, focusing on five countries: Jordan, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, and Yemen, in addition to a number of regional programmes.

# WOMEN'S SOCIETAL EMPOWERMENT

## - A PATH TO GENDER EQUALITY

**KVINFO's international partnerships focuses on four areas, identified as central to gender equality:**

- Legal reform and equal access to justice
- Women's economic empowerment
- Women's political empowerment
- Gender research and documentation

### WOMEN'S POLITICAL EMPOWERMENT

**Worldwide, women are underrepresented in political organs.**

**KVINFO:**

Trains women with ambitions of becoming politically active.

Supports legal equality in national constitutions.

### WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

**Women's rates of economic participation are lower than men's.**

**KVINFO:**

Educates HR leaders in inclusion and diversity in the workplace.

Trains female artisans, enabling them to create viable businesses of their crafts.

### GENDER RESEARCH AND DOCUMENTATION

**There is a lack of knowledge about gender equality outside the Western World and the available knowledge is underutilised.**

**KVINFO:**

Supports the implementation of a research library and a master programme in gender and development.

Stages international conferences on various aspects of gender equality.

### LEGAL REFORM AND EQUAL ACCESS TO JUSTICE

**Many countries have discriminatory or inadequately implemented laws on divorce, inheritance, and protection against violence.**

**KVINFO:**

Trains organisations advocating for a gender equal legislation.

Works to abolish the practice of child marriage.
