Three mentoring programs in the Nordic region invite you to attend our hybrid conference on 'The Potential of Civil Society in Migrant Labour Market Integration'. The aim of the conference is to bring together actors from civil society organisations and the public and private sectors, to discuss how the labour market integration of migrants – particularly women fromso-called 'non-Western' countries – in the Nordic region can be improved by strengthening cross-sectoral collaboration.
